Criteria For NJHS

Academics

• Students must have at least a 90% overall GPA at the end of Quarter 3.

School Service/Co-Curricular Activities

 Students must participate in <u>two school activities</u> (clubs, sports, student government) OR <u>one school activity and one outside activity</u> during the school year in which they apply.

Community Service

- Students must complete a minimum of <u>15 hours of community service</u> within the school year they apply.
- The 15 hour requirement may be fulfilled through participation in one organization over a period of time, or through several different events/groups where the accumulated time equals fifteen hours over the course of three quarters.

Activities that <u>WILL NOT</u> be counted:

- Babysitting (private/family)
- Working for a family or friend's business
- Simply donating money or goods
- Completing home chores
- Caring for a neighborhood pet
- Shoveling snow in neighborhood driveways
- Participating in events for which the student received payment
- Participating in any activity that is not done through or for a specific organization

Activities that WILL be counted:

- Middle Country Library Volunteer Programs
- Cleaning a park
- Collecting items for charity such as clothes, food, toys, or furniture
- Helping the elderly in nursing homes/hospitals
- Helping the local fire or police service
- Volunteering at a local library
- Volunteering in local churches
- Volunteering at a local charity event
- Tutoring
- Volunteering at a food pantry/shelter(s)
- Volunteering at an Animal Rescue/Shelter
- Holiday decorating around your neighborhood
- Recycling project
- Volunteer in Main Office/Wing Office/Nurse's Office/Attendance Office
