## SOME OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Absence notes must accompany your child upon his/her return to school with the reason for absence clearly stated.

A snack time will be reserved each day of school. Please send in a nutritious snack and drink daily. Students are allowed to have water on their desks throughout the day.

If your child will be buying lunch or a lunchtime snack, I suggest that all money be put in an envelope, Ziploc bag, or wallet labeled with your child's name and room number. Stagecoach also has a prepaid lunch service available. Information will be sent home explaining how the program works.

When inclement weather is predicted, please be sure to pack a quiet recess activity for your child to play with during indoor recess.

Your child will be getting homework daily, Monday through Thursday. Please be sure to **check** and **sign** each night's homework assignment.
