STUDENT NTHS CANDIDATES:

It is the policy of the Society that each member school establishes and maintains its own candidate membership standards and selection criteria.

NTHS members should be good, honest, responsible student-citizens who have made a personal commitment to excellence and who agree to uphold the NTHS Standards of Conduct found below.

NTHS candidates must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0. The national average our schools are using is in the 3.5-3.75 range.

Schools may also use the following:

- *An additional GPA requirement for technical courses*
- *One or more faculty and/or staff recommendations*
- *Active involvement in student government, CTSO, civic, or service organization(s)*
- *Attendance*
- *Discipline records*

HONORARY NTHS CANDIDATES:

Publicly honoring individuals within your community (H.R. and staffing directors, civic leaders, educators, etc) who have made important contributions to your students and school is fundamental - a major part of every NTHS induction. NTHS Honorary memberships build strong community support, business partnerships, and bring local leaders face-to-face with your top students.
