Student Nominations

Academic and Non-Academic Requirements

NTHS members must maintain an overall GPA of ____ and maintain a Career & Technology GPA of ____ to remain an active member. The student cannot have any current discipline & attendance problems.

Chapter and Community Service Requirements

All NTHS members are expected to be active in the society. NTHS members are also expected to be active in community service. NTHS will accept service hours from any Career and Technical Service Organization (CTSO) Service project (outside school hours). In addition NTHS will have community service projects with a focus on promoting Career, Technical and Agricultural Education.

Graduation Honor Requirements

Members must have attended 50% of general meetings. Members that have accumulative a total of 50 hours of community service will be eligible for a graduation cord. For the first year, 2006-2007, seniors will only be required to have 25 hour for a cord or 50 hour for a stole.
