Strategies for Multiple Choice Questions

What you can do while reading the \mathbf{TEXT}

- **READ** the story and **take NOTES** in the margin
- Preview questions
- Underline key words and important details
- **Underline** the **topic sentence** this contains the main idea

What you can do while reading the multiple question the **FIRST TIME**

- Understand what the question is asking
- Look at the clue words in the question
- Try to answer the question before looking at the choices
- Look at all the choices

STRATEGIES for Answering Multiple Choice Questions

- 1. **Logic** uses common sense
 - Infer read between the lines
- 2. Process of elimination cross out
- 3. **Text Based Support** look back in the story
 - Highlight answer in the text
 - Skim for certain words in the text
- 4. **Grammar** based on the question can you exclude a choice because it is grammatically incorrect

a)brain b) condrias
c) vacuoles d) powerhouse
(is = singular answer, are = plural answer)
