SQ3R

This is a strategy to read a textbook more efficiently.

Before you read:

- **1. SURVEY** Look over the section you are about to read. Pay attention and *read* the *headings*, *subheadings*, *pictures*, *graphs and captions*.
- **2. QUESTION** Create a question out of the subheading.

Question words – Who, What, Where, When, Why, and How

Question Word + Verb + Subheading

Example – *Subheading*: Native Americans *Question*: Who were the Native Americans? After you make up your one question – write it down.

3. READ – Read the selection. (Don't read more than one subheading section at a time – this helps you to remember the information)

After reading:

- **4. RECITE** Answer your question you made up before you read.
- 5. **REVIEW** This now becomes your study guide.
